

Year of Prayer for General Synod 2022

ACA Prayer Cycle and Calendar of Bishops

In July of 2021 the Anglican Communion Alliance (ACA) invited all Anglicans to pray intentionally throughout the next year for the meeting of General Synod, scheduled for July 13-17, 2022 in Calgary, Alberta. One focus during that year will be to pray specifically for the Bishops of the Canadian Church. At our monthly prayer vigils we will pray specifically for the Bishops of each of the Ecclesiastical Provinces of the Anglican Church of Canada. To assist in this, the Bishops will be approached and asked to help guide our prayers for them by identifying for ACA their specific prayer requests for their Dioceses, for the upcoming General Synod and for the work of the Church in Canada and elsewhere.

The following is the cycle for this focus – the ACA prayer vigils are usually scheduled for the first Wednesday of the month. The meetings are by ZOOM beginning at 7:00 pm (Eastern). If you are able to join us, contact us to request the link for the meeting. If you cannot join in at those vigils – please consider using this cycle to inform your prayers in preparation for General Synod 2022.

The ACA commends these two prayers for use over the coming year:

ALMIGHTY and everlasting God, who by thy Holy Spirit didst preside in the Council of the blessed Apostles, and hast promised, through thy Son Jesus Christ, to be with thy Church to the end of the world: We beseech thee to be present with the General Synod to be assembled in thy Name July 13-17, 2022. Save its members from all error, ignorance, pride, and prejudice; and of thy great mercy vouchsafe so to direct, govern, and sanctify them in their deliberations by thy Holy Spirit, that through thy blessing the Gospel of Christ may be faithfully preached and obeyed, the order and discipline of thy Church maintained, and the kingdom of our Lord and Saviour enlarged and extended. Grant this, we beseech thee, through the merits and mediation of the same Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
